



## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER SCHOOL MEALS**

- Any money on SPUSD students' accounts will be rolled over into summer and the following school year.
- Student PIN numbers do not change at a new school. They will be the same for their entire SPUSD career.
- Students' accounts will be moved to their summer school location.
- Free and Reduced eligibility will be honored thru summer school and through the first thirty calendar days of the next school year. You must apply each year.
- Free and Reduced Meal Applications will be accepted for summer school.
- 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders attending the middle school: Breakfast and snacks will be sold during the morning break. Combo Meal and snacks are served at the lunch break.
- SPHS: Combo **lunch** meal, a la carte entrées, and snacks are available during the morning break.
  - The Grill and The Tiger Express will be open.

**Incoming TK and Kindergartners** that are attending SPUSD for the first time will need to apply for a temporary PIN number if they would like to utilize prepaying on the point-of-sale system using [Myschoolbucks.com](http://Myschoolbucks.com). The application is available on the SPEF forms page. Students may also bring \$ each day, but having a PIN will ensure a smooth process.

**Out of district attendees** may also apply for a summer meal account for prepayment purposes. If you have attended previously, please send an email to re-activate your account.

### **Registering on Myschoolbucks.com.**

1. Once you have received your PIN you may go on to [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com) and register. You may also access thru [www.spusd.net](http://www.spusd.net), click on Departments, then Food and Nutrition, then click Pre-payments tab. Read about options on this page. *(Menus and meal applications can also be accessed here!)*
2. Create a user name and password, click on "Add a Student", then "**Your site**". Use your PIN to complete the registration. You may deposit money on your account online using either a credit card or checking account, or make deposits directly with your site's cashier.
3. **\*\*Make sure to sign up to receive an email when your balance is low!**
